

Dear _____:

Your name has been provided to us by Raytheon as being part of a group of individuals who might be owed money pursuant to a class action filed on behalf of Raytheon employees for unpaid wages. We are Plaintiff's counsel in the case, David Henderson, et al. v. Raytheon Company, Case No. 381868, currently pending in the Superior Court of Los Angeles.

In particular, our lawsuit contends that Raytheon did not comply with California law when implementing Alternative Work Schedules – commonly referred to as “AWS” e.g, a nine day, eighty hour every two weeks schedule (“9/80”) or four day, ten hour every week schedule (“4/40”).

Contrary to what you may have heard, we are not trying to do away with any current schedule you may be working. Voluntarily choosing to work a 9/80 or 4/40 AWS schedule as you may have done does not relieve Raytheon of its obligation to follow proper procedures for implementing an AWS. In a nutshell, this lawsuit is about whether or not you are owed back pay.

It is only the willingness of employees such as yourself by which we can determine whether you are owed wages and what the amount of those wages may be. In order to assist in that effort, we urge each of you to fill out the attached surveys and return it to us by mail, or fax as soon as possible to:
